SUMMARY

No one today is in any doubt that the indoor environment can constitute a real health hazard if buildings are not properly designed, constructed and maintained. The 690 papers presented at the Sixth International Conference on Indoor Air Quality and Health held in Helsinki, Finland, are an indisputable proof of this.
