This international conference follows the first conference on this subject held in Prague in October 2002. Hospitals are amongst the biggest employers and there are numerous occupational exposures to pollutants in the hospital environment. These include anaesthetic gases and vapours, fixatives, disinfectants and biocides as well as a range of airborne infectious agents.

Perhaps of even greater importance is the fact that so many patients in hospitals are particularly vulnerable following surgery or have impaired immune systems or are diseased or debilitated or are elderly or newborn. There is a need to protect both workers and patients and to prevent nosocomial infections. Operating theatres and intensive care units require particularly clean air and thus specialised ventilation systems. The conference will address a range of hospital hygiene problems due to poor quality in their indoor environment and will explore possible methods for amelioration.
